

Saint Aloysius Church 2012 Mass Intention Request

Due to the great number of requests for announced Masses and an increased number of parishioners, we are accepting Mass Intention requests *only* through the use of this request form. It is necessary to limit your requests to “**2**” (**two**) Mass Intentions per family, per year. Please note the following:

- If the exact time and date you requested is not available, the closest available Mass time and date will be assigned. Please indicate which is more important—the date or the time.
- All requests must be accompanied by the proper stipend for each Mass requested. (Checks payable to: St. Aloysius Church)
- We CANNOT take any requests by telephone.
- Please enclose a self-addressed STAMPED envelope or provide an email address so that we may notify you of the days and times assigned.
- We regret that once the Mass book is filled, we cannot accommodate any additional requests. Any request we cannot honor will be returned along with the stipend. However, Perpetual Enrollment will always be available.

Mass Intentions are accepted for:

Daily Masses:	Monday through Saturday at 8:00 a.m. \$15
Sunday Obligation Masses:	5 p.m. Saturday; 7:00, 8:30, 10:30 a.m., 12:30 and 5:00 p.m. Sunday \$15
Perpetual Enrollment:	Members are prayed for each 1st Saturday of the month at the 8:00 a.m. Mass \$25
Sanctuary Lamp:	The candle that burns next to the Tabernacle. The lamp will burn for one week for your intention \$25 (limit 3 weeks per requester)
Nursing Home:	First four Tuesdays of the month \$15

Parishioners who have need of a Mass Card to bring to a wake may arrange for one by coming to the Parish Office Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Please understand that by taking more Masses than what is allowed you are making it impossible for others who have lost loved ones to have a Mass said for them. It is our hope to provide a fair chance for everyone to have their families remembered.
